Cecil Wayne Rogers, 83, passed away on July 7th, 2015 in Bellingham, WA. He was the husband of Joyce Rogers. They shared nearly 57 precious years together.

Born in Hobart, Kiowa County, Oklahoma, Cecil was the son of James Elonso Rogers and Clara Belle Yount. He graduated from Hobart High School and was a veteran of the Korean War.
