Charles Allan Rogers, 88, of Bellingham, passed away and went on to be with the Lord on June 17, 2014 in Bellingham. He was born in Welches, Oregon to Philip R. and Ella L. Rogers on Oct. 10th 1925. He served in the US Navy from 1943 – 1948, stationed in the South Pacific during World War 2. He married Elta Little on Sept. 19, 1947.

A member of the Operating Engineers Union, he established his own automotive shop (Chuck's Tune Up and Repair) which he operated from 1958-1965. He was Port Engineer in King Cove Alaska, and Chief Engineer on a Commercial Dive boat out of Anchorage, after which he worked for Klausen Engine in Bellingham and owned and operated a gillnetter fishing boat.

He will be remembered for the love he poured into his family, church, neighbors, friends, countless picnics and camping trip. He loved boating, the water, yodeling, and music in general.
