Charlotte Wilma Rorabaugh was born 12/14/1911, in Tuxedo, WA, just 2 miles east of Everson. She died 8/8/2012. She was the youngest of Jake and Flora (Kale) Bergs 5 children: Gladys (& Neel Berg), Percy (& Helen) Berg, Loleta (& Allan Hart) and Hattie (& Phil Mades). Though a native and resident of Whatcom County for 95 years, she lived in Kirkland, WA for the last 5 years, closer to her three sons, Bob (& Jan), Tom (& Ruby) and Mike (& Martha) and their families.
