



## Elizabeth Lavery

September 22, 1962 - April 11, 2017

Elizabeth Lavery passed away on Tuesday morning of an apparent heart attack. The youngest daughter of the late Bernard (Bernie) Lavery and Marguerite (Sullivan) Lavery, "E.A." was a the youngest of her generation and the youngest of five siblings. She attended Ferndale schools, the Lysee d'Francais of Los Angeles and Highline College. After a few years at home she moved to the East Coast where she took care of her boyfriend through his final illness and subsequently his mother until she died last summer. She then returned to Ferndale to care for her own mom to whom she had just served breakfast when she had her attack.

As a child E.A. was a constant companion of her father as he made the rounds of the sporting events in the Ferndale area. As she said, "That was the best time to talk with him". As an adult she was an unapologetic fan of all the Boston area teams especially the Patriots. You always knew where she would be on Sunday after church..... in front of the TV rooting for Tom Brady to pull off a last minute win yet again.
