Tony received the WWII Victory Medal, Army of Occupation Medal Japan and M1 Garand and Carbine Marksman Badge. After the army, he returned to

Lithography working long hours, on holidays and for many years until his retirement.

Tony loved his job, the military, 49ers, music, dancing (especially the jitterbug), dressing up to look his best, cars, going to the movies, watching his shows, hanging out and parties with his wife and friends, golf, travelling, going to the gym and going for a walk.

Tony was a great dad and grandpa. He loved, and was so proud of, his children and grandchildren. He was always so acknowledging of his family and friends, making us feel important and loved. Above all else, Tony will be remembered as a husband to his amazing wife Josie, whom he married on May 29, 1948. He was head over heels in love with his wife. He was always so affectionate to her, showing all of us what it means to love in the most passionate and fun way. Even at times when Josie had enough of Tony's personality, he would ingratiate himself back onto her good side. The way he looked at his wife will be forever missed and never forgotten.
