Graham Quick, age 82, passed away peacefully in his sleep on January 28, 2018. Graham was born in Bellingham on December 6, 1936 to Tess Quick and his adoptive father Arthur Quick. Graham graduated from Bellingham High School and then Western Washington State College (WWU) with a Business Degree.
