Jonathan “Jon” David Mayers, with his mother and father by his side, died March 12 at his home in Bellingham, WA, following a long battle with cancer. He was 32 years old.

Jon was born March 26, 1989, in Wenatchee, WA, but lived most of his life in Bellingham. He grew up playing sports of all kinds, notably soccer but also basketball, football, and tennis.

He graduated from Bellingham High School in 2007 and went on to receive a business/computer science degree from Western Washington University. In 2014, he earned a geomatics degree from Bellingham Technical College.

Jon held various jobs, including working for Sudden Valley Golf Club, Fred Meyer’s pharmacy, and Core Design as a land surveyor in the Seattle metro area. He spent multiple summers fishing in Kenai, Alaska. His international travels took him to multiple countries in Europe as well as Israel and India, where he has extended family. He loved outdoor activities and trying new foods from restaurants across the Pacific Northwest.

Jon was a man with many interests and hobbies. He was an avid fan of all the Seattle-area sports teams and would always have a creative recipe to make for family gatherings.

One of his more recent passion projects was renovating a large, white cargo van for traveling around the US.

He was diagnosed with a rare form of cancer called Ewing's sarcoma in 2016.

Jon is survived by his mother, Victoria, and father, Gabriel (Gabe); brother, Joshua, and sister-in-law, Jaymie; three nieces, Elia, Lila, and Olivia; aunt Jasmin, uncles Lonnie, Chris, John, and Ben, oma Maija and grandma Sherrie; a loving extended family from Israel and India and a close-knit group of friends who were always with him through his final days.
