Joseph Lebovich, 77, died August 22 at the Whatcom Hospice House in Bellingham. Joe was born August 26, 1935, in Cairo, Egypt, to Albert and Selma Allouan Lebovich. Joe was a structural engineer which allowed him to live, work, and raise a family in the U.S., Europe, South America, and the Middle East. In addition to English, Joe spoke French (his first language), Spanish, and Italian fluently, as well as Arabic and Dutch. Joe loved Dixieland music, Patrick O'Brian's Aubrey/Maturin series, racquetball, poker, swimming in the Mediterranean, listening to his son Jake play the piano, and eating sambusaks. He and his son, Jake, loved to watch tennis together, and Jake read Joe the daily comics. Joe's wit was dry, and his smile infectious.
