Margery L. Kirkman, resident of Olympia, Washington, formerly of Bellingham, passed away from natural causes on March 11, 2021, at the age of 92 years.

Margery was born in 1928 in Mesa, Colorado and spent her childhood living on the family ranch in Mesa. She graduated as class valedictorian in 1947 and spent one year attending college in Grand Junction, Colorado.

Margery met her husband Harley during an extended visit with relatives in Bellingham, at a church gathering in 1947. They were married in 1948. Harley preceded her in death in 2018. They raised four children, Connie (and John Dunton), Stephen Kirkman, Nancy (Brend), and Karen (and Aaron Evich). Her six grandchildren, Sarah Heistand, Holly Ruby, Parker Coffman, Amy Sue Manley, Allison Phillips, and Alizabeth Dunton brought much joy to Margery's life, and she was also blessed with seven great-grandchildren.

Margery was always involved in church choir, along with Harley, both at First Presbyterian Church in Bellingham and Lacey Presbyterian in Lacey, Washington. She also sang in the choir at the RV park in Arizona where she and Harley spent the winters.

Margery loved to travel and spent time traveling with Harley across the United States, and in the Caribbean and Europe. They spent nearly twenty years

wintering in Mesa, Arizona.

Margery will always be remembered as a very kind and giving person, and would often sacrificially give her time, energy, and resources.
