Richard (Dick) Joseph Carr, 84, passed away peacefully on January 1, 2024, surrounded by his beloved family in Bellingham, Washington. Dick was born in Great Falls, Montana, on December 13, 1939 to Joseph E. and Evelyn A. Carr.
