Teresa graduated from Assumption Catholic School and worked at the Public Market selling vegetables. She married Myer A. Bornstein in 1932, raised 6 children, and traveled extensively. She was a member of Sacred Heart Church, loving wife, mother, sister, friend, grandmother, great grandmother, and great-great grandmother – five generations.

Teresa is preceded in death by her husband Myer, son Anton, and brothers Frank and Lawrence Tiscornia.
