Wallace Little, age 86, passed away on October 17, 2012. He was born in Yakima, WA on October 4, 1926. At that time his parents were picking apples at the peak of the season. Two weeks later he arrived in Whatcom County where he spent the rest of his life.

He joined the navy at 17 and went into service at 18. After boot camp in Farragut, ID, Wally was sent to Hawthorne, Nevada Naval Ammunitions Depot. There he drove trucks loaded with ammunition over the Sierras to Port Chicago, CA until the end of the war.

After discharge, he returned to Bellingham. He completed high school then tried a variety of jobs before eventually settling into a printer's apprenticeship. For the next 20 years he worked in the printing trade. When printing was replaced by more modern methods, he purchased Gus & Nap's Tavern which he ran for many years. Wally was an avid baseball and softball fan and he sponsored many softball teams while there.
